**DEFENDANTS’ OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR A STAY OF
BRIEFING OF PORTIONS OF DEFENDANTS’ PARTIAL MOTION TO DISMISS
PLAINTIFF’S FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT**

On June 25, 2011, Plaintiff National Security Counselors (“NSC”) filed a Motion for a Stay of Briefing of Portions of Defendants’ Partial Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff’s First Amended Complaint. Dkt. No. 13. Rather than setting forth new arguments, NSC simply incorporated into its motion the arguments it made in its identical motion for a stay in the related case National Security Counselors v. CIA, No. 11-444. On June 28, 2011, the Court issued a minute order denying NSC’s motion for stay in NSC v. CIA, No. 11-444. Defendants respectfully request that the Court issue a similar order in this action, denying NSC’s identical Motion for a Stay of Briefing of Portions of Defendants’ Partial Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff’s First Amended Complaint.
